Role Assignments and Descriptions

Position	Number of Volunteers	Role Description
Starter	1	Call boats to start: Ensure that all boats are correctly aligned and ready to begin the race. Start each race using a megaphone: Clearly announce the start of each race using a provided megaphone to ensure all participants hear the signal.
Timers	2	Record times for each paddler: Use provided stopwatches to accurately record the finishing time for each paddler. Ensure accuracy: Verify and double-check times to maintain fairness and accuracy in race results.
On-Water Rescue Team	3	Patrol in Rec Kayaks: Actively patrol the water in recreational kayaks to provide immediate assistance to paddlers in distress. Provide on-water rescue assistance: Be prepared to rescue paddlers who capsize or encounter difficulties during their race.
Motor Boat Safety	2	Ensure safety on the water: Operate motor boats to monitor the race course, ensuring the safety of all participants. Assist in emergencies: Quickly respond to any emergencies or incidents that occur on the water.
Boat Assignment	6	Assist participants: Help participants with getting on and off the water, ensuring a smooth transition at the dock. Maintain equipment: Ensure all equipment is in good working order and readily available for use.
Finish Line Judges	3	Write down the order of paddlers' numbers: Accurately record the order in which paddlers cross the finish line. Assign times accordingly: Use provided papers and pens to note the times and ensure proper documentation of race results.

Position	Number of Volunteers	Role Description
Coaches	2	Send athletes out on the water: Prepare athletes for their races by ensuring they are in the correct boats and ready to race. Assign boat numbers: Distribute and manage boat numbers to ensure proper identification of paddlers during races.
Competition Secretary	1	Collect all result information: Gather results from various officials and enter them into a computer. Print and post results: Print the results on paper and post them on the result board sheet. Gather registrations: Collect all athlete registrations at the beginning of the day. Assign athletes to race cards: Assign athletes to race cards provided by the competition sport coordinator.
General Oversight	1	Zak Mahmoudi: Oversee the entire event to ensure smooth operations and address any issues that arise. Coordinate volunteers: Manage and coordinate all volunteers to ensure they understand and perform their roles effectively.
Lunch	2	Collect and distribute lunch and drinks: Organize and distribute meals and drinks to volunteers. Fill in for other volunteers: Provide temporary coverage for other volunteers during bathroom breaks or other short absences. Ensure everyone is hydrated and well-fed: keep everyone energized and focused.
